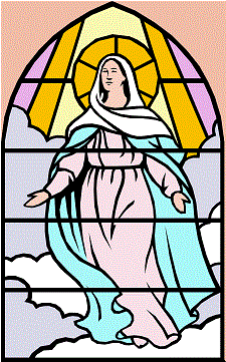

From the Pastor's Desk



A saint in the making, **Blessed Michael McGivney**, a parish priest from Connecticut. Fr. McGivney served the immigrant Catholic population in a climate of Anti-Catholic sentiment in both politics and society. He worked to alleviate the suffering of the newly arrived and working poor by forming the Knights of Columbus in 1882 with an emphasis on our Catholic Faith, Unity, and Charity.

With his cause for canonization moving forward, Blessed Fr. Michael will be the first priest of Connecticut to receive such a distinction from the Church. Called an "Apostle of Christian Family Life" I invite you to invoke his intercession for peace in your family as well as in God's family.

God our Father, protector of the poor and defender of the widow and orphan, you called your priest, Blessed Michael McGivney, to be an apostle of Christian family life and to lead the young to the generous service of their neighbor. Through the example of his life and virtue, may we follow your Son more closely, fulfilling his commandment of charity and building up his Body which is the Church. Let this inspiration of your servant prompt us to greater confidence in your love so that we may continue his work of caring for the needy and the outcast. We humbly ask that you glorify Blessed Michael McGivney on earth according to the design of your holy will. Through his intercession, grant the favor
I now present (here make your intention known).
Through Christ our Lord. Amen.
