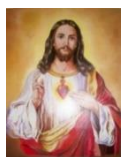
From the Pastor's Desk



August 26 is the Feast of Our Lady of Czestochowa, an icon of the Blessed Mother revered not only in Poland but also around the world. Also known as “Our Lady of Jasna Gora” or the “Black Madonna,” tradition holds that this picture of Mary and the child Jesus was painted by St. Luke the Evangelist on a piece of wood cut from the table used at the Last Supper. Christians in Jerusalem presented it to St. Helen, mother of Emperor Constantine. The image has undergone many unique events as it found its way to Poland. It is venerated by Pope John Paul II, royalty and peasants, young and old alike. On a pilgrimage to Poland, I was impressed by the image and by a unique way by college students make a pilgrimage to the site and offer prayers while crawling on their knees around the sanctuary, wishing to do well on their academic exams.
