FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A student once asked me "why was Jesus so mean to that lady?" You have to admit that the conversation between Jesus and the woman seeking help for her daughter was a bit harsh. In the end He is compassionate and provides the miracle for which she has begged. Did He really compare her to an unwanted, scrounging dog with no right to His help?

Jesus was quite dramatically calling attention to the great faith of this non-Hebrew person. Her faith was greater than that of anyone else. She was not brought up in the Hebrew tradition of longing for a messiah, but her personal faith told her that Jesus was the only one who could help save her child. He is not teaching her a lesson but the crowd around her. He desires that they believe in Him as much as this "outsider".

Time and time again throughout the gospels, we see Jesus offer miracles to what the Hebrews would consider "outsiders" such as the Canaanites, Romans, and Samaritans. He is demonstrating the inclusivity of God's Kingdom. An invitation is extended to everyone who wants to transform their lives into the life of Christ. He does not abandon the Children of Israel, He opens his arms to receive everyone who is willing to accept His teachings, His love, and His miracles.
