

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The glory of the Son of God revealed for Peter and James as witnessed by Moses and Elijah. The last lines of the gospel are intriguing as Jesus admonishes the two apostles not to tell anyone what they had just experienced until after the Resurrection. Who could they have told that would actually believe them? How would they convince anyone of the incredible experience on the mountain top?

The glory of God as described in the all the readings this weekend is too much for our human comprehension. The glimpse into the magnificence was overwhelming for the two disciples as they dropped to the ground in awe. God came to us in human form to redeem us, coming as a gentle infant at Bethlehem. God came to save not drive away. Christ could simply reveal his glory to us each time we come to Mass with all the grandeur of the Transfiguration, but he understands our human limitations and freely chooses to come to us through the bread and wine at each Mass.

Our soul recognizes what the mind may not. "Behold the Lamb of God, behold the One who takes away the sin of the world...." Whether an infant in the manger, a rabbi in the synagogue, a victim on a cross, Jesus the Son of God Most High reveals Himself to us. During the elevation rites of the Eucharistic Prayer, the Lamb of God, the moment we hear the words "the Body of Christ," or during Eucharistic Adoration, Jesus the Christ offers us all of His glory, all of His love, and all of His eternal life.

With the remaining days of summer, take some time to reflect on Christ in the Eucharist. Join us for adoration on Monday evenings anytime between 6 and 7 PM or Friday mornings from 7:30 to 8:00. Our hearts and souls will echo the words of St. Peter as we exclaim, "Lord how good it is for us to be here!"
