If you have a family member or neighbor that has questions about this, especially as regards to their faith, please do not hesitate to contact me and we could talk and pray about this or whatever else is troubling them.

In most communities, there is a crises team made up of counselors, teachers, first responders and clergy. This does not seem to be the case here, but it doesn't mean the clergy are not willing and able to assist our young people and/or their families.

RACHEL'S VINEYARD WEEKENDS FOR HEALING AFTER ABORTION

If you are suffering from an abortion, experience the healing love of Jesus Christ on a Rachel's Vineyard Retreat weekend **October 25-27**, **2024**, **in Litchfield**, **CT**. The weekend healing process includes discussions, Living Scriptures with meditations, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a Memorial Service and Mass of Entrustment.
