From the Pastor's Desk

In the gospel this weekend we hear an account of the call of the earliest apostles. The fishermen put to work by Jesus as he uses their boat as a stage for his preaching to the people on shore. Then he instructs them to go out and cast their nets to receive a wonderous catch of fish.

How did this happen? At first, Christ came to them, and they hung around. They listened and followed his instructions even when it didn't seem to make sense. That's called living a life of faith. Encounter Christ and then follow no matter what. He accepts and most importantly answers our questions. He understands our hesitancy and calms our fears.

If we hope for an increase in vocations, we need to start by introducing the next generation to Jesus Christ, his message, and his Church. At baptism, parents and godparents promise God they will do just that. Pray for parents that they have the necessary deep love for God and their children. Pray that in love they will be willing to grow in faith with their children. Daily prayer, weekly Mass and constant love helps a family grow strong in the faith. Strong families help the Church grow vocations.

Think about it. Pray about it. Most importantly, do it!
