From the Pastor's Desk

The death of Pope Francis the morning after Easter has really enhanced my Easter experience. We saw how he entered into the eternal resurrection, the unending Easter. Like the apostles in the upper room, we now process the death and resurrection as we wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Cardinal Electors in the Conclave this week.

Cardinals under the age of 80 will gather to pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. This holy gathering of delegates from around the world will be the "Tools of the Holy Spirit" in discerning the successor of St. Peter, successor of Jesus Christ. Locked in seclusion in the breathtaking Sistine Chapel, with its inspiring artwork, they will pray, reflect, and vote as the Spirit guides them.
